Leadership through “Team Care”

According to the National Coalition on Healthcare, healthcare costs currently represent 16% of the Gross National Product (GNP) and continue to increase. The rate of the uninsured continues to climb and currently represents approximately 20% of all Montanans. In addition, the industry has witnessed managed care, increased governmental oversight and regulation, a malpractice crisis, and consolidation of providers who deliver care. New technologies and new drugs are constantly being developed. The pace of change is accelerating and there seems to be no end in sight.

As a leader in the Great Falls medical delivery system, the Great Falls Clinic works hard as a team of providers to institute positive change for our patients throughout Montana. Recruiting and retaining the most contemporary physicians and employees requires the latest in technology development. We must utilize these available technologies to meet the needs of an aging population and create more value for the patients we serve. The combination of physicians and employees working together to improve patient care is our commitment and can be defined as “Team Care.” It means striving to constantly perform better services and create more value for the people we serve. Embracing change, creating value and improving team care is the underlying premise behind the Great Falls Clinic’s new Specialty Center.

On August 15, the Great Falls Clinic will open its new Specialty Center. The center will encompass 108,000 square feet of medical space, with approximately 32 new physicians and 135 non-physician staff added to the Great Falls Clinic payroll. The new Specialty Center will allow Clinic physicians and employees to move procedures safely from the Surgery Center setting into the office setting thereby creating savings for our patients. Pain management services and gastroenterology services including colonoscopies will be performed in the office avoiding a facility charge while still doing the procedure in a safe manner. The Clinic Radiology Department will grow from approximately 7,000 square feet to 20,000 square feet and will add many new technological improvements, helping the



Clinic to recruit more effectively in many specialized areas of medicine and create more value for the patients we serve. Clinic Cancer Care will enable all of our medical oncology providers to work together with urologists, surgeons and other specialists in the same facility, and will create a team care environment for cancer treatment. Clinic Cancer Care will also add Radiation Oncology, including newer innovations such as IMRT and HDR brachytherapy, that will improve the care that cancer patients throughout Montana will receive. Clinic Cancer Care is working in collaboration with U.S. Oncology to compare national clinical data to improve care. They provide an onsite pharmacist as a part of our team. We are currently exploring collaboration with the Seattle Cancer Care Alliance which includes the University of Washington, Fred Hutchinson Cancer Center and Seattle Children’s Hospital. This will ensure our specialty providers the most contemporary technologies available, clinical trials and patient education. Clinic Cancer Care has partnered with Shodair in Helena to bring its expertise to patients in need of genetic counseling. The concept of teamwork extends beyond the walls of our organization.

The Great Falls Clinic is proud to be the largest independent group of physicians in Montana, but also understands that with that comes responsibility. Our responsibility as we continue to grow is to create more value for the patients we serve. One thing that will not change moving forward is that we will continue to have physicians and employees working together to bring the population of Montana the best healthcare possible. Our Great Falls Clinic team will continue to provide leadership in medicine through teamwork!

Electronic Medical Record

Our new paperless electronic medical record (EMR) enables our physicians and healthcare providers to access patient information including demographics, laboratory reports, transcribed documents, radiology reports and a Health Summary, which includes a patient's vital signs, medications and allergies from any of our locations and outreach clinics. Utilizing the EMR throughout the Clinic's medical system helps to improve patient care, reduce medical errors, increase productivity and eliminate paperwork.

Laser Skin Treatment

The Great Falls Clinic has several physicians and healthcare providers who are now performing a variety of procedures using our Sciton Laser. With this technology, we are able to offer our patients options to help eliminate spider veins and redness and to remove unwanted hair.

Radiation Therapy

Clinic Cancer Care gives patients access to the latest and most advanced radiation therapy technologies. The purpose of all radiation treatment is

to destroy the cancerous tumor while minimizing the adverse effects on nearby healthy organs and tissues.

Radiation Oncology is a service provided by a team that consists of our Radiation Oncologist, Medical Physicist, Dosimetrist, Radiation Therapists, and Nurses. Clinic Cancer Care has state-of-the-art equipment and treatment planning systems that allow patients to receive the most advanced radiation oncology care available.

Surgery - LAP-BAND Weight Loss System

The LAP-BAND system is the least invasive, safest and only adjustable and reversible bariatric surgical option available. A Great Falls Clinic surgeon, Dr. Stephen Hennessey, now offers patients the LAP-BAND system as a surgical option for their obesity. The LAP-BAND helps patients achieve sustained weight loss by placing an adjustable band around the upper part of the patient's stomach to reduce its capacity.

Surgery - VNUS Closure

A Great Falls Clinic surgeon, Dr. Michael Orcutt, offers patients a clinically proven, minimally invasive procedure that treats varicose veins and their underlying cause, venous reflux, with little or no pain. Closure patients can walk away from the procedure and be back to everyday activities – either at home or at work – typically within a day.

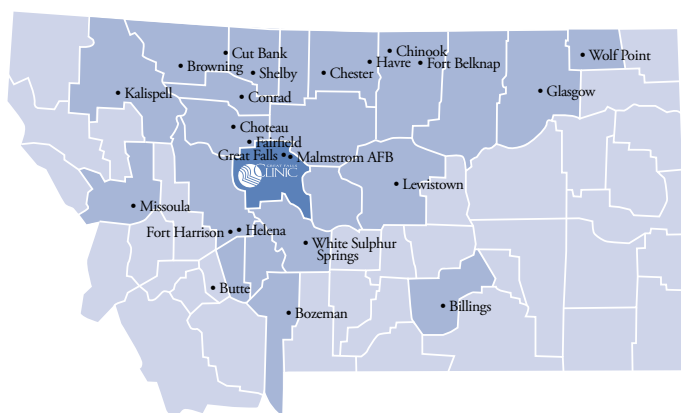
